Recycling centres worldwide process thousands of tonnes of plastic each per month. However, uses for this recycled material remain limited. The Good Plastic Company's recycled plastic panels enable new applications for this valuable resource. On the other side, businesses all around the world are implementing circular economy business models, driven by regulation and market demand. This sustainability transformation is a substantial challenge but also represents an opportunity for all companies in the value chain. Businesses need a tangible way to demonstrate shared values to their customers and enhance brand affinity. Incorporating recycled materials into retail and commercial interior implementations is a highly effective method for brands to make a powerful impression.

Polygood panels are produced from a wide range of post-consumer and post-industrial plastic waste sources, from refrigerators to single-use cutlery, electronics and industrial consumables.

We believe that by generating demand for products made from recycled plastic we can keep this valuable material from ending up in landfill, the oceans, or incinerators. We demonstrate to companies that they can make beautiful and functional new goods from locally produced waste and make a visible commitment to the circular economy.

Our aspirational goal is to substitute virgin plastic and other non-sustainable materials everywhere possible, thus making recycled plastic a new norm in design and architecture

OUR MANUFACTURING IS THE HEART OF OUR COMPANY

We have developed and are patenting to process recycled plastic from different waste streams and turn it into beautiful surface material. This allows us to collect a wide variety of data parameters during processing, including temperature and melting points, pressure, time, and melt flow index.

Our proprietary technology enables us to make recycled panels of the highest quality, which is supported by laboratory test results and certifications to international standards. Our two current factories in the Netherlands and Ukraine are able to produce more than 1,000 tonnes of recycled plastic panels per year, meeting industrial-scale demand










WHERE DO WE SOURCE RECYCLED PLASTIC RAW MATERIAL

We partner with large recycling centres all over Europe that collect, sort and recycle plastics in order to ensure a high-quality and reliable supply of material. They work both with postconsumer and post-industrial plastics. We and our suppliers have procedures to ensure that we can guarantee the composition of our products to our clients. Working with large-scale recyclers allows us to keep stock consistency over time and in large volumes.
